Year 11 – Target Grades

Your child has been set the target grades enclosed based on their Key Stage 2 data and national statistics. Your child is capable of achieving these targets if they plan for the exams, follow the advice of their teachers and start revising consistently. A small amount of revision everyday will ensure that they achieve highly and are successful in the May Exams. Please speak to your child about their revision schedule and which subjects they will prioritise for the upcoming Grade Indicator Exams.

When are the Grade Indicator exams?

The next set of Grade Indicator Exams (Mock Exams) start on Monday 21st November and will run for two weeks. These exams will inform the grades used for Sixth Form applications. It is therefore important that students look at their targets and plan a revision schedule. We will write to parents with the exam schedule and more information later this month.
