Year 11 - 23|11 Programme, Afterschool and Saturday Intervention

The next Grade Indicator Exams (mock exams) start on **27th February**, the second week after half-term.

To ensure your child achieves their very best in their second GIs they need to attend an afterschool intervention programme. Without it they run the serious risk of underachieving this summer and that is not acceptable. **NAME** has a personalised plan which they are expected to attend and should be viewed as part of the school day. We urge you to support us in supporting your child to succeed.

What is the intervention?

Using the data from the last Grade Indicator Exams staff have identified the topics which your child needs to improve on. Students have been grouped together according to their learning needs and staff have prepared resources to improve exam performance.

How long will the intervention run?

The intervention programme will start on **Monday 16th January** and run until the GI exams start. Intervention is from **3:15pm-4:30pm afterschool** and **9:30am-12.00pm on Saturdays** unless otherwise advertised. GCSE PE students have intervention at 7:45am on Thursdays.

On Saturdays they *do not need* to wear their school uniform. However, smart casual dress is expected and any inappropriate clothing will result in them being sent home.

Can my child do intervention for all subjects?

No. English and Maths are essential for students to access Level 3 courses for sixth form (A levels or Vocational subjects). Therefore, where students have not made sufficient progress in English, Maths or Science this has been given priority. Some subjects are also running lunchtime intervention.

What is my child expected to attend?
