### **Year 11 – One to One Online Maths tuition**

Your child has been identified as being at risk of not achieving a grade 4 in their Maths GCSE in their public exams in May. Grade 4 or above is the minimum requirement so access Level 3 courses in the Sixth Form or with other Post 16 providers.

In addition to the afterschool programme and the Saturday interventions run by our own staff we are going to ask your child to undertake a programme of online study with a Maths tutor.

#### **When will the programme run?**

Girls will have an online lesson on Fridays 3pm-4pm. This will last for 15 weeks.

#### **What will they be taught?**

Students will sit an initial assessment and then the tutor will build a tailor-made programme designed to ensure your child gains a Grade 4 or 5.

#### **How many students will be in a group?**

The tuition is one-to-one to ensure that your child gets the bespoke support they need and tackle the topics they need to focus on improving. This information will be shared with the students so they can revise key topics at home too.

#### **What do I need to do?**

We enclose a permission letter from the tuition company which will allow us to share information with them about the needs of our learners. Please sign this and ask your child to return it to the Maths department.

We expect that we will see an improvement in their results in the March Grade Indicator Exams and in the final results in August. We seek to provide your son with every opportunity to improve in such an important subject.
